## **Participant Code of Conduct**

It is the goal of the Friday Night Rec program for all participants to have an opportunity for a safe and enjoyable experience while taking part in our programs. In order to assure all participants understanding the behavior expected the following code of conduct has been developed. Failure to follow the code of conduct may result in verbal and/or written warning, removal from activities and/or suspension from future activities after repetitive violations. If you observe behaviors that could be considered inappropriate, please report it to the program director.

3. Stay with your assigned group and leader.
4. Keep your hands to yourself.
